(1) Includes shares for restricted stock grants: 4,500 which vest on 11/1/2009; 22,500 which vest on 1/3/2010; and 4,500 which vest on 11/1/2011.

(2) Includes 12.646 shares acquired through the reinvestment of dividends on July 2, 2009 at a price per share of \$20.903.

(3) The number of underlying securities is based on the stock fund balance on July 2, 2009. The actual number of shares issuable upon the distribution date is not determinable since the stock fund is a unitized account consisting of 96% company stock and 4% money market fund. The stock account balance reflected in this report is based on a July 2, 2009, stock fund price of \$20.69 per share.

(4) Each share of phantom stock is the economic equivalent of one share of Johnson Controls common stock. Shares of phantom stock are payable in cash following the reporting person's termination of employment with the company and may be transferred by the reporting person into an alternative investment account at any time.

(5) The phantom stock units were accrued under the Johnson Controls Retirement Restoration Plan and are to be settled 100% in cash upon the reporting person's retirement or other termination of service with the company.

(6) Includes 7.827 phantom stock units acquired through the reinvestment of dividends on July 2, 2009, at a price of \$20.69 per phantom stock unit.

(7) The phantom stock units were accrued under the Johnson Controls Annual Incentive Compensation Plan and are to be settled 100% in cash upon the reporting person's retirement or other termination of service with the company.

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- (8) Includes 77.774 phantom stock units acquired through the reinvestment of dividends on July 2, 2009, at a price of \$20.69 per phantom stock unit.

- (9) Each share of phantom stock is the economic equivalent of one share of Johnson Controls common stock. The restricted stock units were accrued under the Johnson Controls Restricted Stock Plan. The units represent the reinvestment of dividends and are to be settled 100% in cash upon the vesting of the reporting person's Restricted Stock Grant.

- (10) Includes 207.912 phantom stock units acquired through the reinvestment of dividends on July 2, 2009, at a price of \$20.69 per phantom stock unit.

- (11) Fifty percent of the options become exercisable two years after the grant date; the remaining 50%, three years after grant date.
