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ITEM 5.03 AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OR BYLAWS; CHANGE IN FISCAL

YEAR.

On January 26, 2006, the Board of Directors of Berkshire Hills Bancorp, Inc. (the "Company") voted to amend the Company's Bylaws to remove the age limitation provision, which provided that: (1) directors elected after January 10, 2000 could not serve past the annual meeting immediately following their seventy-second birthday; and (2) directors elected before January 10, 2000 could not be reelected following their seventy-second birthday, but could serve until the expiration of their term.
