(1) This transaction was a cashless exercise of options to purchase 20,101 shares of Common Stock. The exercise price for the stock options was paid in the form of 16,401 shares of Common Stock owned by the Reporting Person valued at an aggregate of \$221,250 based on the \$13.49 closing price of Enzo Biochem's Common Stock on October 17, 2005, the exercise date.

(2) As of the date hereof, the Reporting Person directly beneficially owns 171,901 shares of Common Stock, 4,765 shares of Common Stock in Enzo Biochem's 401K plan and 62,598 options to purchase Common Stock, par value \$.01 per share which are currently exercisable.
