ITEM 5. *Other Events.*

On March 7, 2002, Tenet Healthcare Corporation (the "Company") completed an offering of \$600,000,000 aggregate principal amount of its 6 1/2% Senior Notes due 2012 pursuant to its existing \$2,000,000,000 shelf registration statement. The notes were underwritten by a group of investment banks led by Credit Suisse First Boston and Salomon Smith Barney as the joint book-running managers, and Banc of America Securities LLC as the joint lead manager. The terms and conditions of the underwriting are set forth in the Underwriting Agreement dated as of March 4, 2002, filed as Exhibit 4.1 hereto.

The terms and conditions of the notes are set forth in the Indenture dated as of November 6, 2001, between the Company and The Bank of New York, as trustee, filed as Exhibit 4.2 hereto, and the Fourth Supplemental Indenture, dated as of March 7, 2002, between the Company and The Bank of New York, as trustee, filed as Exhibit 4.3 hereto.
